



# Targeted Tax Area Fact Sheet

Qualified companies located within the Targeted Tax Area can receive up to \$31,500 in State Tax Credits for hiring individuals meeting one of the following criteria. The credit is received incrementally over a five year period.

## Criteria for Targeted Tax Area Eligibility:

- Enrolled in Job Training Partnership Act
- Participant in Welfare to work activities under Cal Works
- Member of a federally recognized Indian Tribe or Native American
- Economically Disadvantaged
- Military Veteran
- Targeted Tax Area Resident
- Collecting unemployment benefits
- Public Assistance Recipient
- Formerly Self-employed
- Ex-offender

If the applicant meets the eligibility criteria or resides in the Targeted Tax Area, he or she may be considered a potential Targeted Tax Area qualified employee.

## Referring Employees to Qualified Employers

To qualify for the Targeted Tax Area Incentives a business must be located within the Targeted Tax Area's Business Incentive Zone (BIZ) and must have one of the following Standard Industrial Code Classifications (SIC Codes).

2000-2099	Food Processing
2200-3999	Certain Other Manufacturing (paper, printing, chemicals, petroleum, plastics, wood, fabricated metals, machinery, electrical equipment, misc. manufacturing, etc.)
4200-4299	Motor Freight Transportation and Warehousing
4500-4599	Transportation by Air
4700-5199	Transportation Service and Wholesale Trade
